

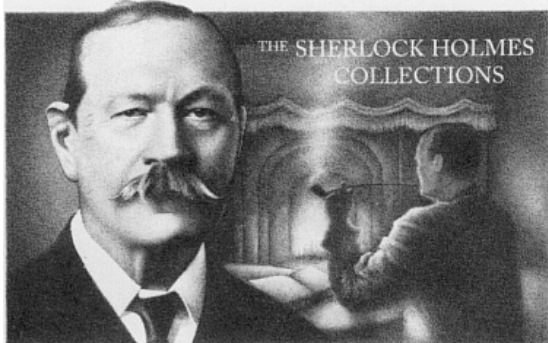
The Friends of the Sherlock Holmes Collections
